Barging Schedule and Costs

Our crew is working hard to get the Pied Piper, barge, and Dovekie ready for the summer. As long as the mild weather holds we should be able to launch the barge the first week in April. We are booking barging beginning April 10th.

CTC operates under a number of legal restrictions for our barge service. We are limited on the type, days, and times of barging trips. However, we are able to arrange barging trips from Yankee Marina in Yarmouth as tides allow. For

The CTC Board has voted to raise barging rates this year. There has not been an increase in barging costs for more than 5 years, despite the increased operating costs. Rates will increase from \$3.00 to \$10.00 one way based upon the type of vehicle.

Major Projects Underway at CTC

The CTC Board is working on two major projects this spring. The first is the possible reorganization of the Company. We are investigating the possible benefits of converting to a non-profit and/or creating a transit district. The ultimate goal is to maximize the opportunities to receive grants for acquiring a ferry to replace the Pied Piper.
