Transport of COVID – 19 Suspected Passengers on the CTC Barge

An individual who has symptoms of COVID-19 may need to go the mainland to see his doctor or to be tested. CTC will provide round trip transportation on our barge at no cost. Following are the procedures for this transport.

If you need to travel to the mainland (or take another person to the mainland) for suspected COVID -19 related issues:

1. Contact the CTC office (846-5227) and request a barge transport.
2. The time and date for the transport will be scheduled.
 - a. You must provide vehicle information to CTC so your vehicle can be identified (Make, model, license plate number)
 - b. There will be no charge for the transport.
 - c. You must confirm your fitness to drive on and off the barge. If you are not fit to drive, then you must provide a driver
 - d. The office will arrange with you to get a signed release from you and your driver, if applicable, prior to the transport.
3. When you transport:
 - a. Arrive at least 15 minutes before transport.
 - b. You and your driver, if a driver is required, must stay in your vehicle at all times with the windows and doors closed.
 - c. You or your driver will be required to drive the vehicle on and off the barge. The crew will give no assistance.
 - d. You or your driver must set your parking brake.
 - e. The crew will not be on the barge. The crew will remain on the push boat, the Dovekie.
 - f. If you need to swap vehicles on the mainland, you can leave the Island vehicle in the CTC parking lot.
