\*Total weight of each barge trip may not exceed 100,000 pounds.

\*Length of vehicle includes the tailgate (if down), cargo on vehicle extending beyond tailgate, and the tongue on trailers.

\*Trailers and vehicles may have freight but vehicles/trailers over 25,000 pounds in weight may receive a surcharge of \$50.00 at the Captain's discretion.

\*Barging to Yankee Marina is subject to a surcharge of \$300 one way Monday - Friday and \$400 one way on Saturday and Sunday. Surcharge will be divided among the number of customers, not vehicles, on the trip.

\*One passenger per vehicle may ride the barge at no cost. If more passengers are allowed (at the discretion of the Captain), each additional passenger will be charged \$10 each way.

\*Vehicles should be at the barge site at least 15 minutes prior to departure.

\*Barging times are tide dependent.

\*Each customer is required to sign a Barge Services Agreement once annually.

\*Customers must load and unload their deck freight.

\*Unattended vehicles staged for barging must have the customer's name and BARGE clearly displayed on the windshield.
