No pricing increases in 2013!

In preparing its budget for 2013, the CTC Board considered all aspects of our service, including our schedule and fees. 2012 is shaping up to be a good year for the company. Ferry ridership has increased about 7%, barge revenue is up 30%, and our charter income reached nearly \$80,000! Accordingly, we have been able to pay down \$90,000 on the Pied Piper loan and will have it paid in full by the end of 2012. These favorable results have led the Board to decide to maintain both the current schedule and pricing structure. All fees will remain at their 2012 level next year. Thanks to our customers and employees for helping us achieve such strong results!
