Attention Stockholders!

The CTC Annual Stockholder Meeting will be held on July 28th at 9:00AM at the Island Hall.

Several weeks before the meeting we will mail stockholders the agenda, board nominations, and proxy votes. If your address has changed since the last time you received a mailing from us, please email ctc@chebeague.net or call the office (846-5227) with the updated address. (It would be helpful if you could call after normal business hours and leave a message).

The annual audited financial statement will be posted on the Stockholder page of the CTC website (chebeaguetrans.com) and a limited number of paper copies will be available at the office at least two weeks prior to the meeting. The password to

the CTC Stockholder page will be included in your mailing.

For several years, stockholders have requested that CTC investigate converting to another type of organizational structure. This year the Board has spent several months considering and evaluating four potential structures: remain for-profit, convert to a 501 (c) 3 non-profit, convert to a transit district, or become a department of the Town of Chebeague.

The CTC Board will make its recommendation regarding changing CTC's corporate structure at the annual meeting.

Your vote is important! In order to hold the meeting, we need at least 30% of our outstanding shares present (either in person or by proxy).

New Policy
Launching from the Cousins Island parking lot
CTC's current policy prohibits any boat launching from the barge ramp at the Blanchard Lot. We are pleased to announce that the policy has been modified. Launching of personal watercraft will be allowed, effective July 1st. Launching from the lot will be allowed under the following conditions:
-Prior approval is received from the CTC office.
-No launching during barging hours.
-A parking attendant must be on duty.
This service is offered as a courtesy, no launching fee will be charged.

Only our crew and our great island rescue team, however, get the call in the middle of the night to transport rescue patients. The night ferry crew is on duty until 6AM and must be on the boat within minutes when called.
