New Policy on Check Cashing

At their May 22nd meeting, the CTC Board of Directors adopted a new policy on Check Cashing. **CTC will no longer provide check cashing services. Checks will be accepted as payment for services only.**

Effective June 1st, CTC will accept checks only under the following conditions:

1. The check is payable to CTC.
2. The check is made payable for the exact amount of the tick-

ets or services being purchased. 3. The company has not had checks returned for insufficient funds from the payer within the last 12 months.
