**Maintenance Planned at Cousins
Parking Lot**

The Blanchard Lot is in need of major improvements to eliminate uneven ground and stumps. We have scheduled maintenance on the lot for the week of May 14th. The work will take several days (leaving flexibility for inclement weather).

In order to accomplish this safely and expeditiously, we need your help. It is necessary to temporarily clear as many vehicles as we can from the lot, especially the central portion where most of the work will take place.

We are requesting that our parking customers utilize the Route One lot for that week if at all possible. People who are unable to do this for work or other reasons are asked to leave a key with the parking attendant (if we don't already have a key) so we can move your car to another spot (if necessary) during the work.

Please leave the key by Monday May 7th.

If your vehicle will be out of the lot **during the day (7am-5pm)**

every day it is not necessary to leave a key. If this is the case, we would appreciate an email or call telling us you will be out of the lot during the day and not leaving a key, so we have a better count of the cars remaining. A parking lot attendant will be on duty full-time the week of the 14th.

We'd like to have all non-essential cars moved by 7 a.m. Monday, May 14th.

We realize this is an inconvenience for our customers, but hope you understand that reducing the number of cars is necessary in order to complete this work quickly. If you can help us by relocating briefly, allowing those who require immediate access to their cars for commuting to remain, it will expedite this project. We will post project updates daily at chebeaguetrans.com and on the Chebeague.org web page. This will be an improvement that benefits all users of the Blanchard lot.
