



CTC has contracted with Fogg Water Taxi of Portland. Effective October 26, 8:15 p.m. water taxi service from the Cousins Island Wharf to the Stone Pier on Chebeague will be available, Monday through Friday. The fare to Chebeague will be \$15.

The addition of this weekday evening boat is in response to requests from several members of the Chebeague community. The \$15 ticket price will help to offset a small fraction of the cost to CTC of retaining Fogg to provide this service. Use of the water taxi, versus running the regular CTC ferry and a second CTC crew to provide evening travel, offers significant savings to the company at a time when revenues and ridership are off sharply.

How to use the 8:15 Fogg Water Taxi:

1. Call Fogg Water Taxi no later than 7 p.m. on the day of travel. The Fogg telephone number is 207-415-8493. You will be asked to provide your name and contact information. Fogg reserves the right not to provide service in inclement weather.
2. You must be at the Cousins Island Wharf at 8:15. If more than six passengers have signed up to use the service, additional trips will be made to accommodate everyone with a reservation. (Each trip to Chebeague is just a few minutes in length, so the wait will not be long.)
3. You do not need a CTC ticket to board the water taxi. Fogg will provide the names of travelers to CTC and CTC will invoice passengers. Payment in full to CTC will be due within two weeks of the date of an invoice.

Please note: Travel from Chebeague to Cousins on the returning water taxi may be available and can be arranged with Fogg. Fares for the Chebeague to Cousin's trip will be determined by Fogg.

CTC will monitor usage of this evening water taxi service and reserves the right to adjust trips and schedules accordingly.
