Advance tickets are \$15 for adults and \$10 for children under 12. Tickets sold on the day of the cruise are \$20 and \$15. Children 5 and under are free. All cruises are weather permitting. Reduced Fares for same day and overnight passengers!

In our survey last fall several customers mentioned that family and friends could not afford to come to the island for a visit due to the transportation cost. We heard you and have been working on a solution.

Effective with the launch of our new website in July, customers will be able to purchase parking and ferry fares for either same day or overnight

passage at a reduced rate.

The tickets can be purchased only on our website and will be paid with credit cards. Customers must present their receipt along with identification on the day of travel.

Parking fees will be \$10, round trip adult tickets \$10, and round trip children tickets \$2.

We hope these new prices will make it possible for more people to visit the island for the day or overnight. More details will be available on our new website.

Changes in Bus

Parking at Cousins

The CTC bus will leave the Route One parking lot 20 minutes before the ferry arrives at Cousins, 35 minutes before the ferry leaves Cousins. When the bus arrives at the wharf it will stop and unload bikes (if needed), pull into the turnaround, and then back out of the turn around and park facing up the hill.

Bus passengers will then be allowed to exit the bus and unload freight. Freight carts will be available at the wharf for customers to use in transporting freight to Chebeague. As soon as Route One freight is unloaded passengers arriving from the ferry will begin loading freight on bus. The bus will leave the wharf as soon as the passengers and freight are loaded. Vehicles are asked not to park or stand at the wharf until the bus is in position. This will still allow more than 15 minutes for the vehicle to be unloaded and parked before the ferry departs from Cousins Island.
