



CTC to Begin Running Trips from Chandler's Cove during Extended Low Tide Cancellations

During extreme low tides, when the first morning boat cannot safely leave the Stone Pier for an extended period, CTC will instead depart from the Casco Bay Lines pier in Chandler's Cove for the trip to Cousins. This will ensure that travelling school children and others can get to the mainland in a timely manner. CTC will also run a trip from Cousins Island back to the Casco Bay Lines pier. Upcoming trips on April 29th and May 28th are listed below.

The change in departure locations will occur only when extreme low tides necessitate lengthy delays in early-morning departures. This new service will allow CTC to continue providing vital transportation to school students and commuters, as well as other travelers. The Casco Bay Lines pier will be utilized for departures at extreme low tides until dredging can be completed at the Stone Pier.

While not as convenient as the Stone Wharf, the Chandler's Cove wharf guarantees adequate water even during extreme low tide events. It will enable CTC to safely transport essential early-morning travelers both to and from Chebeague until the channel at the Stone Wharf can be dredged and normal service restored.
