2022 Annual Parking Applications

Applications for annual parking permits will be mailed November 1st to current permit holders. The application will also be posted on the “Parking Service” page of our website and can be picked up at our office after 11/1/2021.

Each year we receive far more applications for the Cousins Island lot than there is available space. Applicants for the Cousins Lot will be asked to prove residency by providing a copy of a current driver’s license and vehicle registration.

The deadline for Cousins Island annual permit applications is 4pm on December 1, 2021

Applications received or postmarked after that date will be issued a Route One permit.
